

All Saints PCC Feedback

The PCC meeting on Tuesday 8th July opened with the regular discussions about mission and ministry in the Botley Church and Community. The function of the PCC alongside general management of All Saints is to explore ways the church can engage with, and benefit the community at large. As such it is important to share those ideas with the community to encourage involvement and communication.

Key themes from the July meeting:

- Publicity and Communication – The PCC needs to concentrate on publicity/communication and nurture as top priority for work in Mission.
- Baptism Link – the new scheme for communication and connection with baptism families will begin at the Baptism Tea on Sunday 28th September 2014. The Link extends the churches offer for a year following the baptism by communicating about events, services and information of interest to the baptism family
- Simply Breakfast @ Botley has been successfully operating for 2 years between the 8am and 9.30am services on the first Sunday of the month providing breakfast to parishioners. Once the service time changes in September from 9.30am to 10am the breakfast will continue. It is hoped to increase the offering to more Sundays in the month.
- Pilgrim and Beta courses - The Pilgrim course is likely to be 6 sessions from November to the beginning of December. The Beta course will be run in 2 halves with 5 sessions in Lent before Holy Week and 5 sessions starting 2-3 weeks after Easter. More information will be available later in the year.
