

## All Saints PCC Feedback

The PCC meeting on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> February opened with the regular discussions about mission and ministry in the Botley Church and Community. The function of the PCC alongside general management of All Saints is to explore ways the church can engage with, and benefit the community at large. As such it is important to share those ideas with the community to encourage involvement and communication.

The key themes from the February meeting were:

- The Communications Group has met and discussed how and why does the church communicate and who does it need to communicate to. The team identified that the best way to communicate must be balanced so that everyone can hear the message in a format suitable for them. All communications should be relevant, easy to understand and up to date.
- The Pastoral care group are being re-contacted and invited to a meeting on 23<sup>rd</sup> February to explore how best to use the resources available.
- Easter community outreach includes a shoe shine for the village during Lent; Hot cross buns to be distributed on Good Friday in Botley Square; an Easter Egg hunt for children at All Saint's on Easter Sunday; the distribution of a 'Bag of Hope' from United Christian Broadcasting (UCB) for visitors to the church on Easter Sunday; Christian Aid 'Count your blessings' collections throughout Lent;
