

## All Saints PCC Feedback

The PCC meeting on Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> September opened with the regular discussions about mission and ministry in the Botley Church and Community. The function of the PCC alongside general management of All Saints is to explore ways the church can engage with, and benefit the community at large. As such it is important to share those ideas with the community to encourage involvement and communication.

The key theme from the September meeting was a presentation from Mike Gurman the leader of Sunday Club in Botley.

- Sunday Club has been happening on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Sundays in each month. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday is Vegetales – televised bible stories with discussions. 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday is in the foyer with bible study/discussion on a theme followed by a linked craft activity. From September the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday will also have Sunday Club with a different leader.
- There is a rota for helpers with a primary and a stand-by for larger numbers.
- Sunday Club continues through school holidays to provide the facility for visitors and the usual congregation
- The biggest challenge is the variability of the numbers and ages. Sunday Club will always be held even if there is only 1 child.
- There will be a more formal exit and return for the children during the service so it is clearer when they are moving between the service and Sunday Club.
- BCD Searchers held on a Sunday evening in Botley includes children in Y6-8.
- It is intended to have a discussion community for youth work including BCD Searchers, Sunday Club and Messy Church.
